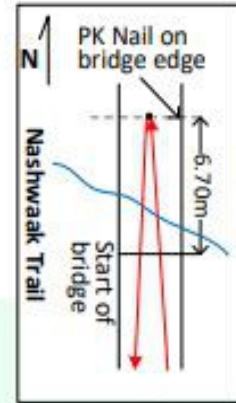


Fredericton Half Marathon

Fredericton NB – Measured by Andrew Ottens and Bruce Macfarlane, on September 29 and November 10, 2024

Runners line up on the south side of St John and Aberdeen Streets. Heading north runners go up St John St to Queen St., turning left towards the north turn lane onto Regent St. Continue along onto St Anne’s Point Drive towards the Westmorland St bridge. Running up the ramp on to the bridge runners continue to the 2nd off ramp exiting onto Union St heading diagonally towards Friel St. Runners continue up Friel St turning right onto the Northside Trail, turning right onto the Gibson Trail. In Marysville, runners turn left onto McGloin St to the Bridge St bridge, crossing and immediately turning right. Runners continue out 2.5km on the Nashwaak Trail to the turn around. Runners return on the Nashwaak Trail, crossing the Bill Thorpe Walking Bridge. Runners continue to Aberdeen St by completing the Half Marathon by crossing the finish line 200m from the trail exit.
