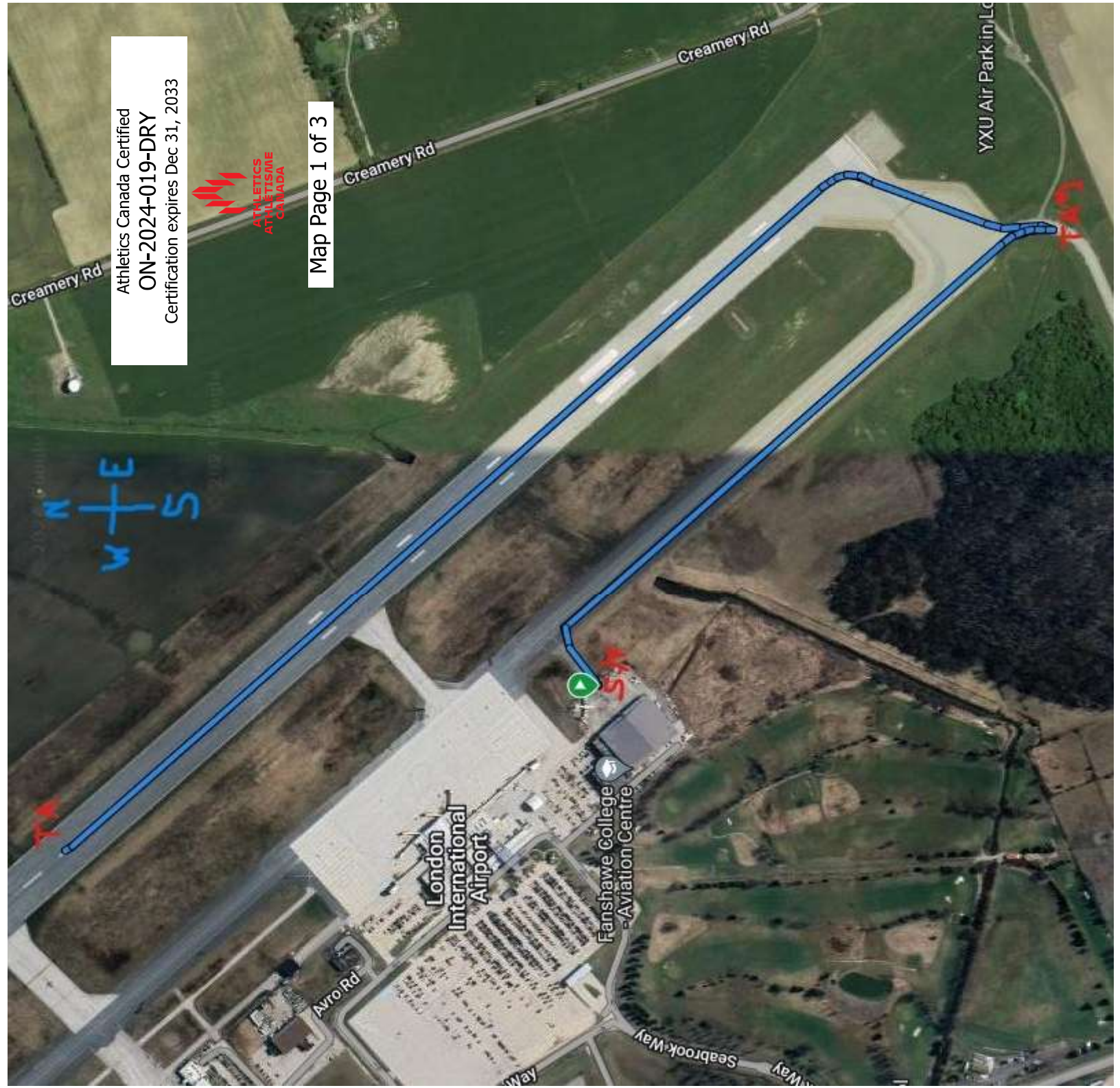
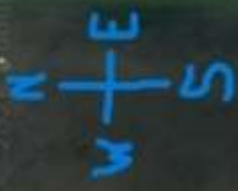

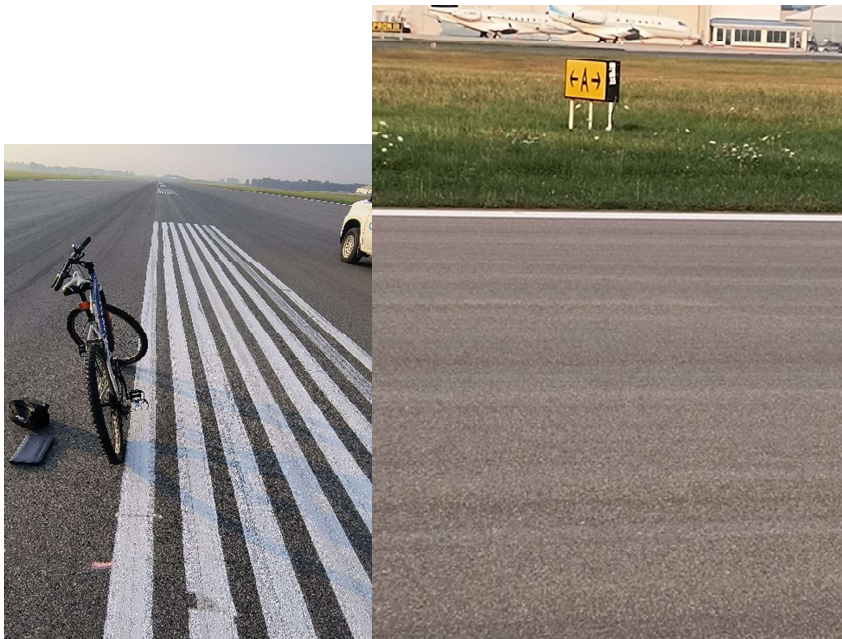

## Jordan's Run the Runway Fanshawe Start

Start- In-line with the edge of the apron in front of the Fanshawe college hanger, runners proceed towards the taxiway and turn right following the shortest path. Runners proceed south on the taxiway and head towards the Foxtrot taxiway leading towards Diamond Aircraft. Runners turn around 1.5m past the sign on the right side denoting Foxtrot. After the turn runners cross the end of the main runway and turn left (North) staying to the right or east side of the centreline of the runway to make their way to the turnaround. Runners turn around here and return as they came to the finish.

2k- In line with the North edge of GHG sign shown.

1k- 1.5m directly out on a diagonal line from the storm drain at the end of the main runway.
