10km Course



The 10km race will start on the roads outside of the Toronto Zoo followed with a scenic loop through the Zoo grounds. ****No strollers, baby joggers or pets are permitted in the 10km race****

Award & Prize Structure for the Canadian 10km Championships

Prize money will be awarded to the top overall Canadian finishers. They must also have a current competitive membership with an Athletics Canada branch association.

1st place male and female:	\$2,000 each
2nd place male and female:	\$1,000 each
3rd place male and female:	\$ 750 each
4th place male and female:	\$ 500 each
5th place male and female:	\$ 250 each

Standards (Related to Prize Money)

The following standard must be met at the championship race in order to be eligible for the full prize money. If an athlete that finishes in the top 5 does not meet standard, they will be eligible for 50% of the prize money.

Men: 31:00
Women: 36:00

Awards

Athletics Canada Championship medals will be awarded to the first three Canadian finishers (Men & Women). Only those who meet the athlete citizenship and membership eligibility can be declared Canadian Champions and receive a medal, award, or financial recognition.

Timex National Road Race Series Finale



The event also serves as the Timex National Road Race Series Finale, the top three male and female individuals will be recognized, as well as the top provincial teams (men's/women's/overall). Please note that even though you will register your Timex teams under the Timex Series Finale, those athletes are still eligible to compete for the National title, as long as they meet the necessary criteria (i.e. Athletics Canada competitive member, Canadian citizen). However, those that register under the National Championship portion will not be eligible to contest the Timex Series title unless they have been named to their Provincial Team.

Team Scoring:

Men's Team – Top 3 to score
Women's Team – Top 3 to score
Overall – Top 2 men + Top 2 women to score

All Timex athletes are eligible for Age Category prizing, with some exceptions. The top three finishers (male and female) will not be eligible for age category prizing, as they will already be receiving prize packages. If a Timex athlete finishes in the Top 5 Overall, who is eligible for National Championship prizing, and the Top 3 Timex, they will receive a combined prize package and both titles (i.e. if a Timex athlete finishes 3rd overall and Top Timex athlete, they would receive the prize money for finishing 3rd, the National bronze medal, the title of Timex Champion, and a prize package from Timex). Athlete Citizenship Eligibility

The following athletes are eligible to compete in National Championships:

- Canadian Citizens who are Athletics Canada members;
- Only Canadian Citizens are eligible to be declared Canadian Champions and receive a medal, award, or financial recognition.

Non-Canadian Citizens

Non-Canadian citizens are not eligible to be declared Canadian Champions and receive a medal, award, or financial recognition.
